Select Junior League of Chicago Community Projects

Proceeds benefit the Junior League of Chicago mission. The JLC is a metropolitan organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of women and improving the community though effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. This year, more than 1,300 JLC members will contribute more than 200,000 hours of volunteer service annually for Chicago area projects that focus on atrisk families, especially women and children. The JLC reaches out to women of all races, religions and national origins who demonstrate an interest in and a commitment to voluntarism.

Connecting Kids to the Arts

This project serves children at local hospitals and children in domestic violence shelters. Our aim is to aid in creative development, while raising self-esteem and allowing for self-expression. Children and their siblings work with our volunteers while their parents take a much needed break or receive counseling.

Journey to Healthy Living

Journey to Healthy Living is a mentoring program that supports women who live the near west side of Chicago. Our volunteers provide consistent monthly programing focused on health and wellness. Programs include free fitness classes, nutrition classes and other wellness information.

Teen Exodus

Provides a mentoring relationship with teen girls from Chicago Youth Program (CYP) from the Near North (previously Cabrini Green) Uptown and Washington Park neighborhoods. Volunteers plan and attend Saturday events with the teens geared toward promoting self-esteem, encouraging higher education, self-awareness, and prevention of teen pregnancy, substance abuse and gang activity. Outings range from pottery making to a yoga class – anything that will be a new and meaningful experience for the teens.

Woman to Woman - The Women's Treatment Center

Our volunteers develop, arrange and lead events and activities to promote self-esteem and help build life and social skills for women recovering from substance abuse. The Women's Treatment Center is a comprehensive treatment center providing substance abuse treatment, medical care and social services for women and their children.

Kids in the Kitchen

Our volunteers plan, organize and execute cooking sessions and fitness activities to empower youth to make healthy lifestyle choices and help reverse the trend of childhood obesity and its associated health issues.

GALS

This project allows JLC volunteers to help children develop an interest in learning by improving their skills through homework help, relationship building, and social interaction in the Logan Square neighborhood.

Done in a Day

The Junior League of Chicago volunteers, their friends, and families participate in a variety of projects such as Rock for Kids and Lincoln Belmont Food Pantry. These projects mobilize support and have an immediate impact in just one day.

Madhatters

JLC volunteers, organized into small troupes, visit schools and libraries to promote reading to children ages 3 to 9. Troupes perform songs, skits, and poems to encourage each child in the audience to expand his/her mind through reading.

LaunchU

A year-long 1:1 mentorship program with high-school seniors who are usually first generation college-bound students. The JLC will be serving as both mentors and volunteers with some of their programs.

Blessings in Backpack

Provides food on the weekends for elementary school children across America who might otherwise go hungry. The JLC will be partnering with Agassizi Elementary School in Lakeview!

Logan Square Neighborhood Association

A community-based organization advancing diversity, leader development, and models for engagement as the catalyst for social justice. The JLC is creating brand-new programming for 8-12 events next year.
